These Simulation Interactor positions are located in Puckapunyal, which is 120 km north of Melbourne, and suit applicants who have their own transport and live within a reasonable travel time/distance. They are casual positions for up to 18 months.

Defence is offering this unique opportunity to a diverse range of people who will assist in the training of combat officers who will become sub-unit commanders and lead troops in a Defence operational environment. You will provide critical support capability to the Combined Arms Training Centre in the conduct of two military courses per year. You will be responsible for operating a Battle Simulation Workstation using Defence simulation software in accordance with specified instructions.

You will be part of an on-call casual employee pool trained to input student plans, implement orders, react to changes and report outcomes, faults, observations, successive decisions and actions into a computer based constructive simulation. The skills required are as follows: accountable for following specific direction, excellent hand and eye coordination, dexterity with computer controls, excellent interpersonal and verbal communication skills and the ability to liaise with different levels of personnel.

The position suits motivated individuals with a positive disposition and the ability to work accurately under time pressure. This may suit university students, small business owners with time flexibility to those with the skills and background to make a productive contribution of the development of army leaders.

The work is intermittent and successful applicants can expect a maximum of 20 days casual work spread over each six week course, twice a year. Courses are conducted in April-May and October-November. Timings to the course schedule may be subject to short notice change to meet curriculum requirements.

Selection tests will be held twice a year at Tobruk Barracks, Puckapunyal and will consist of a computer-based assessment of your ability to use the constructive simulation system. The test will assess attention to detail, computer and mouse skills as well as the ability to accept instruction and precise direction.

Selection testing will commence within the first two weeks of March.
