In particular, working abroad will help to develop a person's adaptability, communication, interpersonal skills and self-confidence. These are all valuable skills in the world of work."

- Expand your professional network

"Building an international network can be incredibly powerful and provides professionals with more options and connections than a home-built network possibly could. While professional networking sites such as LinkedIn provide people with the opportunity to connect with others from across the globe, building relationships face-to-face is much more effective."

Nick advises, "These are all great reasons why professionals should consider an international move to give their career a real boost."

"It's not just beneficial to the individual either, companies can reap the benefits of international mobility too."
